The **Beneteau Oceanis 43 (2011)** is a well-maintained, **single-owner** cruising yacht that blends comfort, performance, and thoughtful design. With **three spacious cabins and two full heads**, including a private en-suite forward cabin, this yacht comfortably accommodates family cruising or extended stays aboard.

The interior features quality wood finishes, ample natural light, and a roomy salon with a **2-meter ceiling height**, C-shaped settee, and a fixed dining table. The galley is fully equipped with an Eno 2-burner gas stove, oven, large 180L Vitrifrigo fridge with freezer, and a built-in microwave, plus all cookware and utensils needed for liveaboard life.

Navigation and onboard systems are robust and cruise-ready, featuring a **full Raymarine suite**: dual chartplotters (C90W and C120W), **radar**, autopilot with EV-400 controller, **AIS Class B**, VHF, and tri-data instrumentation.

The **Yanmar 54HP** engine offers reliable propulsion, complemented by a saildrive and fixed 3-blade propeller. **Four 150W solar panels** support energy independence, alongside AGM house batteries and inverters.

With a **furling mainsail and 140% genoa**, she's easy to handle under sail. This Oceanis 43 is an ideal choice for sailors seeking a turnkey, capable cruiser with the comfort and space



of a floating home.
