Featuring two control bridges, **bow and stern thrusters**, and **two electric winches at the stern**, it offers excellent maneuverability. A **hydraulic gangway** adds convenience for boarding and disembarking.

Designed to accommodate up to eight people comfortably, this Grand Banks 42 has undergone significant upgrades for modern comfort and reliability.

The kitchen, bathrooms, and salon have been renovated, providing a fresh and stylish interior. New 220V electrical installations run throughout the vessel, along with updated water systems to enhance onboard functionality.



The engines have been professionally serviced, and the boat's underwater structure is regularly maintained, ensuring top condition for years to come.
