Description

Najad 391 1997 in excellent condition. The Najad 391 is a quality-built boat from the keel to the top of the mast in superb Orust quality. This copy is very well preserved. A holistic, well-thought-out interior of high quality for demanding yachtsmen. The boat feels the comfort and luxury of wood finishes from the colander to the ceiling. The configuration (the best of the options proposed, in my opinion) is arranged with 6 berths, two in the aft cabin, 2 in the saloon, and 2 in the bow cabin. Aft is the owner's cabin, a spacious aft cabin that accommodates a double bed with quality box springs, plenty of wardrobes, and storage compartments. In the living room, sofas easily transform into two large beds. In the bow, there is a separate shower room, which can also serve as a dryer for wet marine clothes. In addition, there is a large living room with 2 comfortable sofas. The bathroom is spacious and has a toilet, washbasin, and storage space. The L-shaped kitchen is well laid out, with plenty of work surfaces and a large fridge. This boat is ideal for offshore sailors as well as those who dream of a really good Orust construction in excellent condition.

A diesel heater from Eberspr cher but 5 exhausts new lithium battery installation from 2020 of 270Ah means that power problems do not exist and solar cells are not needed. New VHF antenna installation and new throttle with new wiring in 2021. Windlass with 20 kg Bruce anchor and 60 m chain in the bow, manual anchor in the stern 15 kg.
