



Moody 425 for sale in Greece

This beautifully maintained **Moody 425** was moulded in September 1989 and launched in summer 1990. She has been continuously **upgraded and carefully maintained** throughout her life, with **no structural repairs and no history of osmosis or blistering**.

Wintering has always been carried out ashore, leaving the hull clean and sound. The engine and gearbox were **replaced in 2011 with a 54 hp Yanmar**, now with approximately **5000 hours** and maintained by Yanmar; the engine does not consume oil between services.

The **rigging was replaced in 2013** and inspected by a Kemp-approved technician in 2023.

All deck **hatches and windows were replaced in 2022**, the **upholstery is new**, and the interior benefits from extensive teak carpentry finished with seven coats of International varnish.

The galley has a **new oven and cooker**, Corian worktops, **new refrigerator and freezer**, plus an additional small refrigerator.



Comfort is enhanced by 16000 BTU **air conditioning and a watermaker** producing approximately 50 litres/hour.

The yacht is exceptionally well equipped for comfortable cruising and long-term sailing. Navigation and communication equipment includes **Raymarine chartplotter, autopilot, radar and AIS, Icom SSB and VHF, and an EPIRB.**

She carries a Burton Autoprop, new propeller shaft and cutlass bearing.

Two battery banks, a 500 Ah domestic bank and 180 Ah engine bank, Sterling alternator-to-battery management, a **new Victron 50 A** shore charger and a Victron 700 W **inverter.**

Three solar panels are installed on the aft bridge, while an electric two-speed cockpit winch makes handling easier.

The inventory includes a **10 ft aluminium RIB with a 6 hp Yamaha outboard.**

Full sail wardrobe including a lightly used spinnaker and drifter, a 2014 mainsail, restitched staysail, older but good-condition 130% genoa and an additional 100% genoa.

Safety and anchoring equipment includes a **life raft, Mason Supreme anchor, Danforth spare anchor and approximately 100 m of 10 mm chain.**

There is also an extensive collection of tools and spare parts. The boat has been kept to a very high standard and is now looking for a new owner to continue her story.
