



Oyster 37 Heritage Pilothouse for sale in Greece

The **Oyster 37 Heritage Pilothouse** (1985) is a rare and exceptional yacht. Known for its rugged construction and impressive speed, this model is designed for serious sailors seeking long-distance capability without compromising comfort.

The boat features a slab reefing main, forward roller furling with an inner Solent stay, and a **full set of sails in good condition**, including a main, two genoas, a spinnaker, gennaker, and forward staysail.

Equipped with a **50 HP Nanni Diesel** engine, **Max Prop** propeller, 10 self-tailing winches, and a 100-meter rode plus chain managed by an **electric windlass**, it's ready to handle demanding passages with ease.

A **bow thruster and autopilot** system (with repeater **control in the salon**) add to its ease of handling.

Below deck, the Oyster 37 Heritage Pilothouse offers a beautifully laid out and highly functional interior, with the main cabin and galley positioned midship for optimal comfort at sea.



The spacious salon provides panoramic views, creating a bright and airy atmosphere for relaxing or navigating.

Sleeping arrangements accommodate 4 to 6 people comfortably, making it perfect for extended cruising.

A Force 10 stove serves the well-equipped galley, while onboard tanks hold 120 liters of fuel and 200 liters of fresh water.

Topped off with a classic teak deck, this yacht combines Oyster's renowned craftsmanship with all the practical features needed for adventurous voyages.
