

Westerly 33 for sale in Greece

Description

Westerly 33 is a well-maintained sailing yacht, built in 1979 and recently **surveyed in May 2024**. This solid cruiser offers excellent bluewater capability in a manageable 9.95-meter package, making her ideal for coastal cruising or longer passages.

She is powered by a Mermaid Marine MP-332 diesel engine installed in 2012 and used for only two seasons, with a full service completed in 2024.

The boat features **two comfortable cabins**, a spacious saloon, and a well-equipped galley with a gas stove, oven, **refrigerator**, **and hot water**. An **electric toilet with shower**, freshwater tanks, and interior/exterior lighting round out her liveaboard comforts.

On deck, Westerly 33 is ready for serious sailing with **two sets of sails**, a fully battened Quantum mainsail with stack pack, and a Genoa (one requires minor UV cover repair). Her deck-stepped mast, standing and running rigging, and navigation equipment have all been inspected and are in good condition.

She includes modern upgrades such as AIS with Wi-Fi for tablet-based chart plotting, a new solar panel and batteries (2024), and a 3000W inverter (2025).

Safety gear includes new life jackets, fire extinguishers, a life raft (untested), and manual/electric bilge pumps.

With a tender and outboard, **3 anchors with 120m of chain**, and an abundance of spare parts and tools, the boat is a capable and ready-to-sail yacht for her next adventure.
