

Westerly Fulmar 32 in Spain

Description

The Westerly Fulmar 32, built in 1983, is a well-regarded sailing yacht. This vessel has been meticulously maintained and updated since its purchase in 2020, including a comprehensive refit in 2021. Designed for reliability and ease of navigation, the Fulmar 32 features modern enhancements while retaining its robust construction. The boat includes a forward cabin, a convertible salon, and a single berth, along with one head.

The yacht is powered by a Volvo 2020B BT engine from 1997, which is in perfect working order, ensuring dependable performance. It has ample tank capacity with a 90-liter fuel tank and a 150-liter freshwater tank. The sail inventory is extensive and in very good condition, featuring a mainsail, a Genoa, and an asymmetric spinnaker with a sock. The mast and rigging have been significantly upgraded, including a new rigging in 2019, a gennaker boom in 2022, and various rigging protectors and tensioners. Four Barlow winches and complete ropework renewal between 2021 and 2024 further enhance the sailing experience.

The interior of the Westerly Fulmar 32 is both functional and inviting, following a thorough update in 2021. This includes full sanding and varnishing of the woodwork, new upholstery and mats, and the addition of an interior floor carpet in 2023. The galley is well-equipped with a two-burner stove and oven, a refrigerator, and a 30-liter Quick hot water tank. The boat features hot and cold water, a Jabsco toilet, manual and automatic bilge pumps, and various lighting options. Electronics are up-to-date with a comprehensive array of navigation and communication tools, including a B&G Vulcan T7 plotter, Furuno GPS, Garmin VHF, and a range of power outlets. Safety is prioritized with a Plastimo 4-seater life raft, a Lofrans 1000 W windlass, and a 16 kg Delta anchor. Additional extras like an inflatable auxiliary boat, a swimming platform, and various covers ensure this yacht is well-equipped for any adventure.
