



2008 Open Class 40 for sale

Description

The boat was built in 2008 and has many good results in national and international regattas under its former name "Solo".

The boat is a class 40 regatta boat, one of the world's most popular classes for ocean sailing with its own class in the largest regattas in France and England as well as separate regattas just for this type of boat. Although the boat is now a few years old, it has proven itself well, and there are several regattas where older Class 40 boats have their own class. The boat is also fully usable inside, but we have only used it in slightly larger and longer regattas.

The boat is built according to class rules and, among other things, set up with 2 x 750l water ballast and carbon rig.

Sailing such a boat and learning to master the power and speed such a boat performs is a fantastically fun experience and if you have not been in this type of boat before, you will get a lot of new things to brush up on.

The boat has been in storage throughout the corona period. After a summer of various reviews of equipment, instruments, engine and sails, the boat is now ready for new owners.

All sails except the one Code 0 are complete/repared and can be fully used for transport, training and regattas. All sails from 2014 have had minor damage repaired from our use and are in good condition.

- 1 autopilot with Raymarine drive unit and Halcyon gyro compass and ACP 2 processor.
- 1 autopilot with B&G hydr. drive unit and Halcyon gyro compass and ACP 2 processor (not fitted).

- 1 PC connection, USB & WiFi
- 1 horizontal anemometer at the top of the mast
- 1 vertical (carbon) anemometer at the top of the mast
- 2 logs type paddle wheel
- Various displays

*The boat has recently started the shift to NMEA 2000 with: B&G NMEA 2000 Autopilot Processor, Display, Keypad, Gps, as well as a USB converter for better utilization of navigation/routing programs such as Expedition (expedition marine).

- Battery controller for reading A, V, Ah
- Own stand alone chart plotter in the cockpit type Standard Horizon 500 including chart chip
- PC screen integrated in chart table
- Furuno GPS

- 1 pc 5 kw Webasto air heater with 3 outlets
- 3 pcs 100Ah Heavy Duty jelly batteries for consumption.

- 1 pc carbon bow spear (2014)
- Water ballast system 750l per side divided into 2 tanks
- Storage tarpaulin with stand (Some deffekt locks in tarpaulin)
- 1 mooring crib for Class 40 boat, Demountable (Fits flat-packed trailer)
- All falls and joints (2014) (Southern ropes)
- 2 anchors with rope and chain in accordance with class rules.
- 1 pc Jetboil cooking device (2014)
- 2 manual bilge pumps (Inside and outside)
- 2 mattresses for front spikes (stored at home, little used)

The boat is located in Askøy, Seilforening outside Bergen.
