- 3 blade propellor with spare propellor on board
- bow thruster hydraulic (Vetus)

- 2 masts with steps
- Genua and Jib furler system

- · lazy jack & lazy bags for main and mizzen
- · genoa and jib booms running on tracks on the mast
- standing rigging main replaced 2019, forward shrouds main 2023

- genua (2023) brand new, used only in one trial sail
- jib, good condition
- mainsail with full battens, on Harken track, good condition, 3 reef points
- mizzen sail, older sail but still working good, 1 reef point

- massive pulpit to store 2 anchors, shows micro cracks, need rewelding eventually

- 2 x Lewmar winches, need to be serviced

- hard open dodger with solar (2022), sides might be added if needed

- U-shaped galley with countertops on both sides

- 3 fresh water tanks, 600l total

- 2 heads: forward head with electrical flush (2021) and shower, aft head with Lavac vacuum toilet

- Saloon cushions covers new 2021, 3 cushions covers have faded in the sun

- 6 x 100A Lithium Iron batteries from Battleborn (2020) => 7.200Wh of usable battery capacity
- 1600W solar: 400W on davits (2019), 200W on Bimini (2020), on dodger (2022) on sides of cockpit (2023)
- 4 Victron MPPT smart charge controllers (same age as panels) + Victron battery sense to connect chargers
- B2B battery charger Victron 400W (2022)
- 350W wind generator on mizzen mast
- 2 x 12V 100Ah lead acid starter batteries (2022)
- Inverter Victron Phoenix Smart 5000VA (2021)
- All lights have been converted to LEDs

- rudder interior inspected 2021, recoated 2021
- bow thruster vetus
