The **Show 34**, built in 1977 by Barberis Shipyard, is a **well-maintained and seaworthy sailing yacht**, ready for both cruising and comfortable onboard living.

Powered by a **YANMAR 3JH2E** engine with only **1250** hours, it boasts a reliable energy setup, including a battery bank of four 115Ah AGM batteries and two solar panels with a charge controller.

Equipped with essential navigation instruments such as a **FURUNO radar, RAYMARINE ST4000 autopilot, and RAYMARINE ST60 sounder**, this boat ensures smooth and safe sailing.

The rigging includes a mainsail, **Genoa, and Gennaker**??all in good condition??along with a Spinnaker pole for added versatility.

Designed for comfort and functionality, the SHOW 34 features an anti-rolling system, a durable PVC and vinyl Bimini, a folding stern platform, and a folding tiller.

The last haul-out was completed in June 2023, ensuring that **the hull is in excellent shape**. The radio, lifeboat, and emergency equipment need updating, but the boat is fully prepared for new adventures, having a heating system for added comfort in colder conditions.

This is a great opportunity to own a solid, well-equipped yacht, perfect for those looking to set sail immediately.
